## Welcome!

Thank you very much for your support.

Rumors have been circulated in the market about Brigantine in Hong Kong. Please rest assured that Brigantine Hong Kong will continue its engagement in container repairs.

What have changed since our last newsletter:

- We have sold off our Marine Services activities to Waertsila, who
  is a leading ship engine manufacturer and has marine services
  as a core business. Our Hong Kong and Shenzhen activities will
  be transferred to Waertsila over the next four months, while we in
  the meantime will finalize ongoing works for our Marine Services
  customers.
- Our Oil Sludge business will continue unchanged.
- With our Marine Services moving we no longer require our large workshop in Yuen Long. For Container Services being our core business the industrial park is a very expensive place to conduct our operation. We have therefore decided to relocate to a new facility and continue our container services from there. The new location will be in New Territories and we expect to announce the exact location by the end of June.
- We are discussing the handover of our Yuen Long facilities with a new tenant and with the Hong Kong Science Park. We expect to conclude this in August and we expect to move to our new facilities before end of 2011.
- Our activities on-dock MTL in Hong Kong will not be impacted by the relocation. The same is the case for our activities in China.

I hope the above put the information straight and also confirm that Brigantine will continue its container EMR services in Hong Kong, but merely change address.
